Message from SLCF Partners

The Sri Lankan Children Foundation was created in 2015 to work with many institutions who look after poor and disadvantaged children across Sri Lanka. To do this we provide funds, computers, technological support, school resources and other services they require.

We are different in that we deliver these resources directly to the beneficiaries and do not spend any money on western staff ensuring that all the money benefits poor children in Sri Lanka.

Till date we have had many successful projects, completion of a Computer centres in China Bay, Trincomalee, and Atchuvely Jaffna which is considered as the very first centres in the towns, benefiting the community in the area, bridging the digital gap between developed and developing towns. Completion of Sewing centres built in both Trincomalee and Jaffna to promote community entrepreneurship and with the training in sewing provided for wives of fishermen and A/L's students that enabled them to produce baby items & hand loom accessories for commercial purposes. Supported the disadvantaged children for their A/L's exam which enabled them to enter into universities for higher studies. Created a 'SMART' class room by donating a laptop to a recognised girl's school in Trincomalee.

All these successes led SLCF to produce 100 computer graduates, 35 entrepreneurial sewers, 20 successful entry to the universities, Three smart classrooms, Two computer centres, Two Sewing facilities in areas where there Is high poverty Index.

SLCF also has supported with many other infrastructure, culinary and education related resources support for children.

We are embarking some key projects in 2020, continued assisting in building a primary school and a playground in Mannar that will benefit around 250 children and local community children and many more generations to come. We are also aiming on setting up a computer hub in Kandy and in Galle to provide more digitally enabled education support for disadvantaged children.
